LOOP INFO - 22 loops

- (7) Dual Sport A, B & C loops
- (2) 125 + mile A loops
- (3) 140 + mile B loops
- (2) 140 + mile C loops
- (4) Singletrack 100 + mile 'A' loops
- (1) Singletrack 65 + mile 'B' loop
- (6) ADV loops (3) 300 + mile Loops
- (4) Warm-up loops of 26-72 miles for each specific discipline

NAVIGATION INFO

- Navigation by GPS Tracks
- Make your own Roll charts from GPS Track Cue Sheets
- GPS tracks will be e-mailed
- These are Not Guided Rides
- Spot X or Garmin Transponders are recommended.

GENERAL RIDE INFO

- This is a Club Ride. No Guides, No trail marking. Camping is on private property.
- Entry is limited, so you will not get lost in the crowd.
- Cost of the ride is for amenities included with the ride, and not for the ride themselves.
- Club membership is included with Sign-Up fee.
- T- Shirts will be available for *Pre-Order*.

MOTORCYCLES RECOMMENDED

- Factory Dual Sport Models are Suitable for Dual Sport Loops
- A Plated Dirt Bike is *Required* for 'A' Singletrack
- Adventure Motorcycles are Recommended for the ADV Loops

"Through the Rockies, Not Around Them"

- Dual Sport loops are little used 2 Track in a part of Colorado few people ever visit. Loops vary from 140 to 180 miles. Routes are less than 20 % Pavement. 'A' loops include Singletrack.
- Singletrack is little used Singletrack on the Continental Divide in the Rio Grande, Arkansas and Colorado river watersheds. Ride little used 2 track for an unforgettable weekend of trail riding. Less than 15% pavement.
- ADV loops visit iconic ski and mining towns. Aspen to Leadville. PIKES PEAK LOOP. Great Sand Dunes. Follow canyon's, rivers & old Railroad right of ways and mining & stagecoach paths. Multiple mountain passes, both dirt and paved. ADV loops are less than 50% pavement. These loops cannot be found on a map you can purchase.
- Fuel is available for purchase along all routes (100 mile fuel range recommended)

All loops are routes you would not put together on your own:

RIDE REQUIREMENTS:

- **You Must Have:** Plated street legal motorcycle, liability insurance. spark arrestor and a Colorado OHV tag.
- **Please bring a valid ID** and copy of current liability insurance to sign-in.
- **No Refunds.** You may switch riders for a \$20 fee at sign-in.
- **Motorcycles will be inspected** for License plates and a Colorado OHV sticker.
- **Knobbies are required** for Dual Sport routes.
- **You Must be a very Competent Rider to ride the 'A' Singletrack loops.**
- **Purchase your own fuel** on routes.

Sign-Up Fee is \$325 and includes:

- *GPS Tracks for specified Loops of your choice*
- *Roll Charts (Make your own Roll Charts from GPS Cue Sheets)*
- *Primitive camping for 4 nights (Hook-ups extra)*
- *2 Breakfasts (Saturday & Sunday)*
- *3 Dinners (Friday, Sat & Sunday)*
- *Beverages Friday, Saturday and Sunday Night*
- *Lunch on the trail (Specific loops)*
- *Camaraderie of like-minded individuals*
- *Porta – potties*
- *Limited on-site showers*
- *Hot springs pool and showers down the street (Passes available)*
- *Finisher Pins*
