SPANISH BORDER ADVENTURE RIDE

- The Spanish Border ADV ride will take place in Southern Colorado and Northern New Mexico.
- This adventure ride is suitable for 300cc Dual Sport to Open Adventure Bikes.
- The routes are 2 track, dirt roads and as little pavement as possible.
- This is not a Guided Ride. We use Ride with GPS for Tracks, which will be emailed. Navigation & Safety Link

RIDE INFO:

The Spanish Border Adventure is a 3 Day Adventure Motorcycle Ride from Chama, New Mexico. On little used 2 track, dirt roads and Pavement in Northern New Mexico and Southern Colorado.

Day 1 ride from Chama to Tres Priedras along a wilderness boundary to the Chili Line Depot for Lunch. After Lunch continue to Ojo Caliente Hot Springs, where camping is included or you can Lodge with Lodging on you.

Day 2 ride thru Old Spanish Communities, to and along the Rio Grande Gorge, into the Gorge on your way to the High Road to Taos. Spend the night at the Historic Sagebrush Inn or in the Lodging of choice in Taos. Day 3 ride from Taos along the base of the Sangre de Cristo Mtn Range to Red River Canyon and Ski Resort. Then ride over a mountain around the Questa mine to around Ute Mtn (An old Volcano) to the oldest town in Colorado (San Luis). From San Luis ride over the lowest bridge in Colorado on the Rio Grande to the oldest Church in Colorado in Antonito.

From Antonito you'll have your choice of 2 ways back to Chama, both over 10,000 feet. Some dirt or all pavement.



Join Exit Tours Motorcycle Club in 2023 for \$425 and your first ride in included. Your 2nd and subsequent rides in 2023 are only \$325. Club members relatives may ride with a club member in 2023 for only \$299.

The ride will start at a the Elkhorn Lodge & Cabins in Chama, NM near the border with Colorado & New Mexico. Thursday evening, we will have an included pre-ride dinner, bonfire and we'll stay in the Cabins or rooms at the Elkhorn Lodge or in your own RV. (Lodging is on you in Chama & Taos)

Secure Truck parking will be available at the Lodge for the duration of the ride.

Nearby Chama, New Mexico is the kick-off point for the Cumbres & Toltec Narrow Gauge Railroad.



The Ride will include luggage portage so you may ride unencumbered by camping gear. The club will also portage a med size ice chest for you.

You will be responsible for making your own Lodging reservations in Chama on Friday and Sunday (if you wish) and on Saturday night in Taos.

Camping at Ojo Caliente Hot Springs on Friday Night is included.
